

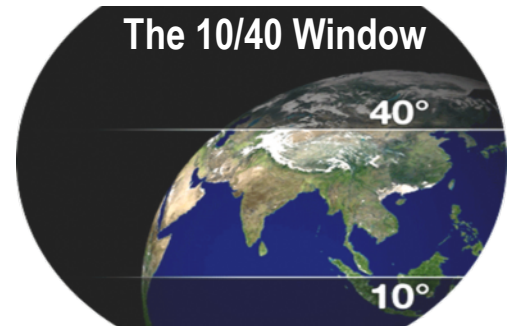

## Sharing the Gospel in “The Golden Triangle”



Most of the Christian Radio programs we work with and sponsor are aimed toward this area of the world - here's why:

- The largest unreached people groups with over 3.09 billion people live here.
- The world's 50 least-evangelized megacities with populations of over one million are here.
- There are estimated to be at least 6,203 unreached people groups in this part of the world.
- Jesus said “Go into all the world” with the gospel. Radio is one effective way to obey His command to reach the lost.

### Report from Stan Smelser of the Christian Aviation and Radio

Using Radio to preach the “Good News” is a team effort made up of announcers, technicians, musicians, writers, and those who “follow up” the broadcasts. In many regions of the world, including parts of South East Asia, being associated with Christianity can be especially difficult and sometimes even dangerous. An important aspect of GBM's ministry around the world is to encourage, enable and help equip those who are on the front lines.

Again this year with your support and financial help, GBM helped sponsor the “Golden Triangle Leadership Seminar” which was started almost twenty years ago by LaVerne Morse (Asia Christian Services). Our mission's sponsorship provided some travel expenses, food, lodging, teaching materials and program speakers for this week-long gathering of over 100 broadcasters, evangelists, church leaders, professors, students, and their spouses. This Seminar brings Christians from more than three countries together - to encourage and be encouraged.

This year my wife Cindy and I were privileged to represent GBM as guest speakers on the subject of “Church Unity”. I led in three sessions centered in Ephesians 4 over two days and Cindy taught the women on Wednesday afternoon. We were both humbled and encouraged through conversations with those attending. They shared stories of imprisonment, trial and victories all because of the Gospel. In addition to scriptural teaching, classes were held on First Aid and Physical Well Being. Each of those attending were provided medical kits to take home to aid in their local ministries enabling them to help and serve their village churches and families.

Conversations over meals often centered on how to deal with problems from within and outside the church. Encouragement was always close hand. Sessions began with worship and I often wished I could bottle their enthusiasm in worship and bring it home. Please pray for the ministries represented by this important seminar. Paul reminds us to “encourage one another and build each other up” 1 Thessalonians 5:11.

New regulations that went into effect in China this month require churches and other religious organizations to “support the leadership” of the Communist Party and “adhere to” the government’s teachings. Further, all churches and religious organizations must be “examined and approved” before they can legally worship ... For example, Article 17 says religious organizations should publicize the guidelines and policies of the Communist Party of China” to the clergy and religious citizens “in order to instruct and direct the clergy and religious citizens to support the rule of the Communist Party of China” and “support the socialist system, follow the path of socialism with Chinese characteristics, abide by the laws, regulations, rules and policies, correctly treat the relationship between state laws and religious rules, and strengthen their national consciousness, consciousness of rule by law, and consciousness of one’s duty as a citizen.”

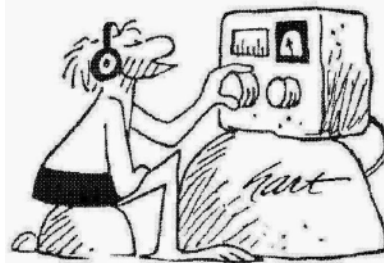
